
## Advent & Christmas





#### ADVENT WREATH

The circle reminds us that God's love has no beginning and no end. The green leaves remind us that God's love never changes.

One candle is lit on each Sunday of Advent. The rose (pink) colored candle is lit on the third Sunday of Advent, sometimes known as Gaudete Sunday.

A white candle in the center of the wreath can be lit on Christmas Eve.

#### First Sunday of Advent 28th November

**Welcome:** Today is the first day of Advent. Advent is a special time when we wait in hope for the coming of Jesus. Let's think a bit more about the things we wait for and what we hope for today.

**Opening prayer:** Dear God, because you love us so much you sent your only Son into the world to be with us. Help us to wait in hope with joyful hearts for his coming and to share your hope with others. Amen.

#### Gospel:

"There will be strange things happening to the sun, the moon, and the stars. On earth whole countries will be in despair, afraid of the roar of the sea and the raging tides. People will faint from fear as they wait for what is coming over the whole earth, for the powers in space will be driven from their courses. Then the Son of Man will appear, coming in a cloud with great power and glory. When these things begin to happen, stand up and raise your heads, because your salvation is near."

"Be on your guard. Don't let yourselves become occupied with too much feasting and drinking and with the worries of this life, or that Day may suddenly catch you like a trap. For it will come upon all people everywhere on earth. Be on the alert and pray always that you will have the strength to go safely through all those things that will happen and to stand before the Son of Man."

#### **Intercessions**


As we wait for the coming of Jesus, we pray together:

# During Advent, something I am hoping for is...

#### Second Sunday of Advent 5th December

**Welcome:** In today's readings we are told that someone very special is coming. Who do you think that might be? John the Baptist tries to help people get ready for this special person. Let's think some more about this today.

**Opening prayer:** Loving God, you want the whole world to welcome Jesus. Help us to prepare for his coming by changing our lives for the better. We make

this prayer to you through Christ our Lord, Amen.

#### Gospel:

It was the fifteenth year of the rule of the Emperor Tiberius; Pontius Pilate was governor of Judea, Herod was ruler of Galilee, and his brother Philip was ruler of the territory of Iturea and Trachonitis; Lysanias was ruler of Abilene, and Annas and Caiaphas were High Priests. At that time the word of God came to John son of Zechariah in the desert. So John went throughout the whole territory of the River Jordan, preaching, "Turn away from your sins and be baptized, and God will forgive your sins." As it is written in the book of the prophet Isaiah:

"Someone is shouting in the desert:
 'Get the road ready for the Lord;
 make a straight path for him to travel!
Every valley must be filled up,
 every hill and mountain levelled off.
The winding roads must be made straight,
 and the rough paths made smooth.
The whole human race will see God's salvation!"

#### Intercessions


We try to make a change to our lives and the lives of others as we prepare for the coming of Jesus, and so we pray together:

Closing prayer: Merciful God, you sent John the Baptist to prepare the people for the coming of your Son, Jesus. Help us to get ready as well. Lead us to make positive changes in our lives and the lives of others around the world. Amen.







# During Advent, I can show peace...

#### Third Sunday of Advent 12th December

**Welcome:** Today we hear John the Baptist preparing people for the coming of Jesus. The people were very excited. John told them they had to change their lives for the better and share what they had with others. Let's think a bit more about that today.

**Opening prayer:** Generous God, we give you thanks for all the good things that you have given us. Inspire us to share what we have so all people may live a full and happy life. Amen.

#### Gospel:

The people asked [John the Baptist], "What are we to do, then?" He answered, "Whoever has two shirts must give one to the man who has none, and whoever has food must share it."


Some tax collectors came to be baptized, and they asked him, "Teacher, what are we to do?"

"Don't collect more than is legal," he told them.

Some soldiers also asked him, "What about us? What are we to do?"

He said to them, "Don't take money from anyone by force or accuse anyone falsely. Be content with your pay."

People's hopes began to rise, and they began to wonder whether John perhaps might be the Messiah. So John said to all of them, "I baptize you with water, but someone is coming who is much greater than I am. I am not good enough even to untie his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. He has his winnowing shovel with him, to thresh out all the grain and gather the wheat into his barn; but he will burn the chaff in a fire that never goes out."



In many different ways John preached the Good News to the people and urged them to change their ways.

#### **Intercessions**

All that we have is given to us by God and so we pray together:

We pray for the Church throughout the world: that it may be a shining example of joy and God's love, welcoming everyone and spreading the message of sharing to all people. Lord, in your mercy...

We pray for all members of our global family: that we may all recognise the importance of our brothers and sisters and share what we can for the good of all people. Lord, in your mercy...

We pray for our communities, families and friends: that we may be moved to care for one another and share what we have so all people can live full and happy lives. Lord, in your mercy...

Closing prayer: Christ Jesus, as Christmas approaches, we look forward joyfully to your coming. Help us to share what we can so all people may have what they need. Amen.

#### Fourth Sunday of Advent 19th December

Welcome: Today we hear how cousins Mary and Elizabeth rejoiced when they saw each other and how Elizabeth knew straight away that Mary's baby was very special. Let's think a bit more about this and about babies around the world.

**Opening prayer:** Caring God, Elizabeth was filled with joy when she saw Mary and knew how special her baby would be. May all parents and their babies around the world have the chance to live healthy and happy lives, with hope for the future. Amen.

#### Gospel:

Soon afterwards Mary got ready and hurried off to a town in the hill country of Judea. She went into Zechariah's house and greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby moved within her. Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit and said in a loud voice, "You are the most blessed of all women, and blessed is the child you will bear! Why should this great thing happen to me, that my Lord's mother comes to visit me? For as soon as I heard your greeting, the baby within me jumped with gladness. How happy you are to believe that the Lord's message to you will come true!"



#### **Intercessions**

We know that God loves us all, even the tiniest baby, and so we pray together:

We pray for all parents around the world: that they may be able to give their children a safe and loving home and encourage them to fulfil their dreams. Lord, in your mercy...

We pray for all babies and children throughout the world: that they may live happy and healthy lives and have hope for a future free from poverty. Lord, in your mercy...

We pray for our parish, family and friends: that we may be inspired to share God's love with all people, no matter where they are in the world. Lord, in your mercy...

Closing prayer: God of all, fill us with joy at the coming of your Son, as Mary and Elizabeth were filled with joy. Help us to spread your love by caring for all our brothers and sisters around the world. Amen.


Once upon a time, A long, long time ago. Begins the story of a baby, That most of you should know.

And all who gathered round Him, Rejoiced and praised His birth. For the babe, the King, named Jesus, Is our Saviour here on earth!





