+ SOME NOTES TO ASSIST IN ARRANGING A FUNERAL MASS +

Have you arranged a musician and/or a singer?	
Will someone speak on behalf of the family?	This is best done at the beginning of Mass.
Will 'symbols of the person's life' be presented?	Ideally also at the beginning of Mass? Who will introduce the symbols? It is best to limit symbols to four or five.
Opening Hymn	
First Reading	What reading and who is doing it?
Responsorial Psalm	
Second Reading	What reading and who is doing it?
Alleluia	
Gospel	It is best to let the priest choose this.
Prayers of the Faithful	Who is writing them and who is reading them? Five or six prayers are ideal.
Offertory	Two people bring bread and wine to the altar?
Offertory Hymn	
Communion Hymn	
Post-Communion Music or Reflection	A prayer, poem or reflective religious music?
Closing Hymn - as coffin is carried from the church	

So what is needed is

- Somebody to speak at the beginning optional
- Some people to bring up symbols of persons life optional
- Somebody (or the same person) to provide commentary on the symbols optional
- Reader First Reading (and for the psalm if it is not sung)- optional
- Reader Second Reading (and for the Alleluia if is not sung) optional
- Four / Five people for the prayers of the Faithful optional
- Two people to bring up the gifts optional

Somebody to read a post-communion reflection (not a second eulogy) – optional All hymn times in red are also optional

Some other things to note

- (1) Concelebrating priests are most welcome to participate in the Funeral Mass.
- (2) Altar Servers are not required but family members who are servers are welcome to participate.
- (3) Family members are welcome to help distribute Holy Communion if they are already commissioned Ministers.
- (4) It is good practice and avoids confusion and upset if it is decided before the funeral who is carrying the coffin into and out of the church and from the hearse to the grave.
- (5) It is best if family members take the front seats on their left (facing the altar) during the Funeral Mass.
- (6) Delegate somebody to collect, immediately after Mass, any symbols brought to the altar.
